- All submissions must be consistent with the conference theme
- All submissions must provide information that attendees can implement immediately
- All submissions must be innovative, research based information and/or strategies
- Commercial materials may not be sold or promoted during breakout sessions
- Sessions will be 1 hour in length
- Presenters may submit more than one proposal
- All proposal must be submitted online

Deadline for submission of proposals is April 19, 2010
