- Curriculum or technology planning committee

Staff Expectations

- Who is responsible for student intake/orientation?
- How will teachers be screened for online teaching?
- What are the expectations for online instructors and how will that information be shared?
- What are the Professional Development needs for your staff?

Student Screening and Orientation

- What will the screening process consist of?
- What will the orientation process consist of?

Student and teacher technology support

- What type of technical support is needed?
- Who will provide this support?

While there are no correct answers for any of the above questions, using them as a guide will help you create a vision and implementation plan for online learning at your school.
